

COST SHARING FLIGHTS

It is noted and agreed that “Private and Pleasure” flights include Cost Sharing Flights, provided always that:

1. The flight is a cost-shared flight by PRIVATE individuals,
2. The direct costs of the flight must be shared between ALL of the occupants of the aircraft, including the pilot, up to a maximum of 6 persons,

Direct costs means the costs directly incurred in relation to a flight (e.g. fuel, airfield charges, rental fee for an aircraft). There can be no element of profit.

Annual costs which cannot be included in the cost sharing are the cost of keeping, maintaining, insuring and operating the aircraft over a period of one calendar year.
