

REPATRIATION EXPENSES ENDORSEMENT

If the Insured Person shall suffer Bodily Injury which independently of any other cause shall Necessitate the repatriation of the Insured Person, the Underwriters will indemnify the Assured up to the amount of the sum insured in respect of reasonable travelling expenses incurred for the repatriation of the Insured Person or in the case of death reasonable funeral expenses and expenses incurred in transporting the body or ashes and in making the necessary arrangements.

The repatriation of an Insured Person shall be deemed necessary if a qualified medical practitioner:

- i) shall estimate that the Insured person is likely to be totally disabled in excess of 4 weeks and/or
- ii) shall certify that the Insured Person should be repatriated because local facilities are inadequate for the treatment of his condition or his recovery will be substantially expedited thereby.

Warranted that all persons to be insured are at inception in good health and free from material physical or mental defect or infirmity and have not suffered from any recurring disease. This warranty does not apply to any condition disclosed in writing to Underwriters and accepted without exclusion.
