

SUE AND LABOUR CLAUSE (2)

In case of any imminent or actual loss or misfortune arising from a peril covered hereunder, it shall be lawful for the Insured, their factors, servants and assigns, to sue, labour and travel for, in and about the defense, safeguard and recovery of the subject matter, or any part thereof without prejudice to this insurance, and Insurers shall meet all such costs.

In the event of damage to subject matter giving rise to a claim hereunder Insurers shall pay, in addition to any loss recoverable hereunder, any additional expenses incurred by the Insured in discharging, handling, storing, reloading or transporting sound and/or damaged goods by any means notwithstanding the original mode of conveyance.
